



## **RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF DAVID'S HOUSE**

Each Board member is expected to support David's House as follows:

- Be fully acquainted with David's House, knowing its history, objectives, programs, finances, and relationships to other agencies.
- Represent the interest of David's House in the community.
- Support David's House with his/her personal involvement.
- Make a personally meaningful financial gift annually to the organization in order to achieve 100% board participation.
- Attend Board meetings and serve on at least one standing committee. Two (2) unexcused absences in a one-year period MAY constitute an offer of resignation. Members are expected to notify the Executive Director if they know they will be unable to attend a meeting.
- Share ability and technical knowledge with other Board members in the development of David's House policy.
- Spend at least two (2) consecutive hours per year at the house to experience its service in action at a time recommended by the Executive Director.
- Keep informed by reading reports and articles dealing with David's House and related matters.
- Avoid conflicts of interest and comply with the David's House conflict of interest policy.
- Make a concerted effort to attend events for David's House.
- Have such powers, duties, and authority as stated in the David's House By-laws
